On May 26<sup>th</sup> we will have a special Honor Guard in McHenry at the Vietnam Healing Wall, *The Wall That Heals.* This almost 300 foot half-scale replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial honors the more than 80,000 service men and women who lost their lives in Vietnam and Southeast Asia. We as an Assembly will provide and Honor Guard on Saturday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. More info will be provided art the May Business meeting. Please attend and then mark Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> to show up in Regalia if you have it, your Tux and Social Baldric, your Red Assembly Shirt if you have one, or your red Assembly teeshirt, any of the above with your Assembly name tag (except if in Regalia!). We ARE the *Patriotic Degree* so let's show the Vets and the Community our support.

It would be a pleasure to have all of the new Sir Knights from this current Fraternal Year, along with their Sponsors, including the new ones to be inducted on May 5<sup>th</sup>, to be at the meeting.
