COLOUR GUARD PARTICIPATES IN CERMONIES COMMEMORATING 100th ANNIVERSARY OF THE BATTLE OF VIMY RIDGE

The Bishop Reding Assembly Colour Guard were prominent in a parade and ceremonies at the Bronte Cenotaph on Sunday, April 9th.

The battle, which began on April 9, 1917 and ended on April



12, 1917, is considered a turning point in Canadian history, where the four Canadian divisions fought together as a unified fighting force for the first time.

While 3,598 Canadian soldiers were killed during the battle, the victory over German forces is regarded as pivotal battle of the war and a symbol of Canadian sacrifice and maturity as a nation in world affairs. (See more photos of the ceremonies on page 8 Knights in Action).
