Meeting Cancellations/Adjustments Due to COVID-19

Because of continuing state of Maryland, Maryland District Knights of Columbus, and Archdiocese of Baltimore actions taken in response to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, in-person meetings and patriotic events have had to be cancelled, postponed, or adjusted.
