#### **GET OUT THE VOTE!**

Dear Brother Knight:

It is just over TWO WEEKS until Election Day! We are into the home stretch and it is time to make the final push to GET OUT THE VOTE through the Knights of Columbus Nonpartisan National Get Out the Vote Program. Help fellow Catholics get to the polls and exercise their right to vote!

Here are the Action Steps for the final two weeks of the program:

#### 1) MAKE APPROVED PULPIT ANNOUNCEMENTS AND ISSUE APPROVED BULLETIN INSERTS!

- Read pulpit announcements at all Masses for two weeks prior to Election Day, advising parishioners who are in need of assistance or transportation to Election Day polls to sign up with a representative from the Knights of Columbus or to take a bulletin for additional information.
- Bulletin inserts in available parish bulletins at all Masses for two weeks prior to Election Day, advising parishioners in need of assistance or transportation to Election Day polls to sign up with a representative from the Knights.

#### 2) HELP A BROTHER KNIGHT TO VOTE!

- Ask a brother Knight to come with you when you go to cast your ballot.
- Offer to pick up your voting companion and take him to the polls on the day of the election.
- Set a specific time to go and encourage your brother Knight to bring along other eligible voters.
- Encourage first-time voters, elderly members, and Knights with busy schedules who might not otherwise vote to come with you when you cast your ballot.

#### 3) ASK MARRIED COUPLES TO VOLUNTEER TO WATCH THE KIDS WHILE PARENTS VOTE!

- Arrange a babysitting service on the day of the election to allow members with young children to leave their children in a safe location, for a short time, with two or three married couples while they go and vote.
- Ask for two or three married couples to volunteer to babysit a small number of young children for a short time to allow the parents to vote.
- The service could be provided throughout the day or in the evening only, depending on the needs and availability of volunteer married couples.
- Keep toys and games handy for the event.

- Consider taking the children to a nearby playground area, but be sure to advise parents that you will be doing this and ensure that there are enough volunteer married couples to properly watch the children.
- Provide snacks for the kids (be sure to first check with parents about any food allergies); bringing milk/juice and a snacks could be a parent's "fee" for the babysitting service.
- Certified or otherwise qualified older children and/or child care professionals may also want to volunteer.

#### 4) USE MEDIA TO GET OUT THE VOTE

- Put a NONPARTISAN "Vote!" reminder on your K of C council or assembly's website.
- Post on Facebook to remind all of your "friends" to vote.
- Send a NONPARTISAN "tweet," or have the Grand Knight or a local celebrity send one, to your following on Twitter.
- Make a NONPARTISAN video *Get Out the Vote* public service announcement, post it on You-Tube, and send an e-mail to everyone in your "contacts" list with a link to the video.
- Knock on doors or man a Knights of Columbus phone bank to reach registered voters who have not yet voted.
- In the United States in the 1800's, voting was a social event, with voting parties held on Election Day at or near the polls. Hold your own Election Day party to make sure everyone votes!

#### In States With Early Voting

Today, many states and the District of Columbia allow "early voting" or "no excuse" absentee ballots or both. This year, voters in 30 states started casting their ballots before September even ended. Thus, about 35% of voters are expected to vote before November 6, 2012. This is still called Election Day, but for many it is simply the last day of an "Election Week" or "Election Month" or an even longer election period.

While about 65% of U.S. voters will still vote at a polling place on November 6, millions of others will vote before then, either at a polling place that's opened early or by mail. In Oregon, all voting will be by mail, as is most voting in the state of Washington. (In Washington, the only polling places on Election Day are at county election offices.)

If your state has early voting, to assure that voters are aware of all of their early voting options, you can do the following:

Publicize when and where early in-person voting will be held.

• Publicize and provide *Rides to the Polls* throughout the early voting period for Knights in your council, their family members, parishioners and other voters who do not have transportation or who need assistance in getting to the polls.

Contact Knights, parishioners and other registered voters by phone or email to remind them that: the period for early voting in-person has begun and that rides to the polls are available

the period for early voting by mail has begun and to complete their ballot and mail it in

- Create and distribute "*Did You Vote Yet?*" stickers or buttons to wear on the days and in the weeks when polling is open, similar to "*I Voted*" stickers given out at the polls on Election Day.
- If early predictions forecast bad weather for Tuesday, November 6, use phone calls or e-mail to encourage Election Day voters to use the early voting option to vote sooner.




#### A Prayer for all Veterans:
