A Prayer for Religious Freedom


O GOD OUR CREATOR,

- **Eligibility:** Each candidate must be: (1) A third degree member in good standing in his council, (2) initiated into the first degree prior to October 20, 2012, and (3) a citizen of the country in which he resides. A citizen of another nation may participate with the specific written approval of both the Master of the appropriate District where he claims citizenship and the Master of the Archdiocese of Washington District.
 - **Fees:** Full payment, made payable to **Master, Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus**, is due with the submission of each application and registration form. The exemplification fee for candidates is \$70.00. Please note that this fee does not constitute payment of dues to the Assembly. A special exemplification fee for priests and members of religious orders is \$35.00. Each exemplification fee includes one (1) banquet ticket. Additional banquet tickets are available at a cost of \$45.00 per person.

The Ladies will enjoy a social and entertainment program on Saturday, beginning at 10:30 AM for a \$25.00 fee. This will include fun, and refreshments. **Casual attire is suggested. Changing rooms are available prior to the evening banquet**. Register by March 19, 2013.

All applications, banquet reservations, fees, and Ladies' Activity reservations must be received by March 19, 2013.
