# FAITHFUL ADMIRAL'S REPORT PGK PFN S.K. Ron Sullivan

We are now into February and the virus continues, and by the looks of the vaccine delays we will be isolating longer than anticipated. Let us pray that our governments have the sense to follow the advice of the medical authorities and take the necessary action to prevent spreading of the virus variants that are developing.

In February we begin the season of Lent, a time of reflection and review. Perhaps this imposed isolation may afford us the opportunity to experience Lent without all the distractions of everyday life. Since we are advised to stay home and limit our activities, we can reflect on our faith life and spend time in thoughtful reflection of the mysteries of our faith.

Hopefully in the not-too-distant future there will be an end to this plague and once again we will be able to meet and participate in meetings of our councils and assembly and when called upon participate in the honour guard of the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree.

On that note we have been advised there is a new supplier of the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree uniform. The price is reduced and now replacement articles are available. The website is <u>https://knightsgear.ca/</u> and all product is now manufactured in the USA where before it was made in Italy and shipped to the U.S. It is now also possible to purchase a replacement uniform item in the event there is loss or damage to an article of clothing. The price quoted is \$449.00 US plus \$139.19 US in shipping and import taxes. In Canadian dollars the cost based on the current exchange rate would be \$576.48 for the uniform plus \$178.71 import duty for a total cost of \$755.19 delivered. The last price from Roger Sauvé was \$752.00 delivered which was less then my original cost from Sauvé of \$832.00; this new price provides no savings. It looks like you can no longer order from Roger Sauvé. The only advantage here is if you are a Florida winter vacationer, you can save the import cost and by purchasing while you are there as your stay in the US qualifies you for avoid import duty.

Stay safe and pray our government, both federal and provincial,. will follow the direction of the medical advisers and this pandemic will soon be behind us.
