FAITHFUL ADMIRAL'S REPORT PGK PFN S.K. Ron Sullivan

I hope all have enjoyed a safe Christmas season although one very much different from previous Christmases. As we begin a new year I would like to look to the future and think about why we became members of the 4th Degree. I would like to give you my reason for joining the 4th.

I am perhaps a late joiner, after 45 years as member of the 3rd Degree I felt I was ready to become a 4th Degree Sir Knight. I felt I served the 3rd degree holding many offices including DGK, GK, FS, Treasurer, Six Points Chairman and was involved in many activities of the 3rd. Perhaps I waited to long as I did not have any intentions joining the Honour Guard, I believed there was sufficient opportunity to be involved in the Patriotic Degree in other ways. I joined as I felt it an honour to be a member of the 4th, a recognition of service with the Knights of Columbus. I recognize that is probably viewed as outdated thinking, but it was the way in which I was introduced to the Knights of Columbus. In the 1960's before being accepted to join the Knights you and your wife would be visited by the membership committee to ensure that you understood what joining the Knights meant, that your wife agreed with this, and that you were a practising Catholic.

In 2010 I decided it was time to join the 4th. I got involved, I served as a trustee, attended the various functions, spoke at the Catholic School for Remembrance Day, and attended meetings. It was a good feeling to be among a group of Knights who for the most part had served in their councils. I did not acquire the regalia as I did not feel I needed to be a member of the honour guard. In 2018 I was nominated to stand for election for the office of Faithful Navigator. I was honoured to accept the nomination and stood for election, and since there was no competition I was elected. I believed that as Faithful Navigator I should be a member of the Honour Guard and I acquired the old regalia by begging and borrowing discarded regalia to use until the new uniform I ordered was received, purchased a sword, service baldric and gloves. I assumed the office of Faithful Navigator June 2018 in the middle of the change to the new uniform, a difficult time for many members.

The point I am hoping to make is that we join the 4th not because of the uniform, but because we want to achieve the final degree, Patriotism, loyalty to our Church and to our country. Whether we are a member of the honour guard or not, being a member of the 4th signifies our service to the Knights and we continue to serve in our councils. You are a Sir Knight; you affirm your loyalty to the Church and country and if possible, visibly represent the Knights of Columbus by wearing the uniform when participating in church and fraternal ceremonies, community events such as special Olympics and Remembrance Day services as well as other public events we are invited to. You do not need to wear the uniform to participate in the Patriotic Degree, you need only to embrace the Patriotic Degree.
