Let us pray:

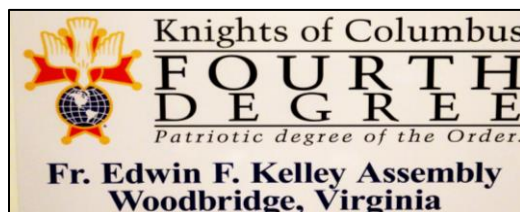

provide him the same support you have shown me over the years. Finally, thanks a million for all your service and support. And as Bob Hope would say, "thanks for the memories."

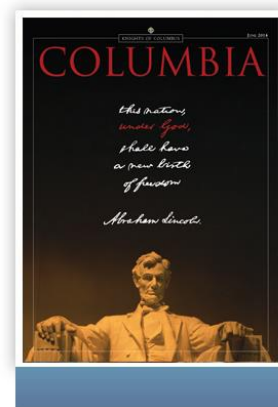

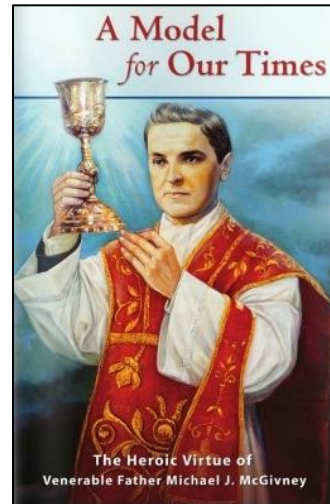


**Prayer for the Canonization of
