FAITHFUL NAVIGATOR'S REPORT

This will be the last newsletter for this fraternal year. The next publication will September 2019. It has been an exciting and challenging year. As of June 30th, the old regalia will be history, ushering in the new dress and a new beginning. This has been a contentious issue as it is difficult to break with the past. There have been dire predictions that this will spell the end of the 4th Degree, much like when the church changed from Latin to the vernacular and heaven forbid,

they changed the altar around, so the priest faced the people. The church survived and some will say it is not the same, but in doing so the church made us aware to accept the consequences of our actions to become participating members of the church and not merely observers. Supreme decided that it was time the Knights modernized, moved into the 21st century. Only time will tell how successful this will be, but I can tell you in our Assembly we will have 15 members with new uniforms. Of this number I can count 12 that will be active members of the Honour Guard. The current honour guard lists a total of 31 members, however, of that number there were only between 8 and 10 active members. At events over the last year the largest turnout was 8. With the new uniform I am seeing new members that will give us 12 active members. I find this encouraging and I support the decision of Supreme to update the uniform regardless of doomsday detractors.

Before we end this year there is one final aspect of business that we have been struggling with and that is the current Memorial we provide for our deceased Sir Knights who are in good standing. It has been the practise of the Assembly to provide an engraved Chalice or Ciborium for each Sir Knight who died during the past year. Over the years the cost of chalices or ciboria has risen dramatically; last year the average cost to purchase and engrave a chalice or ciborium now exceeds \$700. It has

become financially unsustainable to continue this memorial and as the annual dues have decreased due to the number of life memberships and decreasing membership. On average there are just over 90 members paying full dues. Added to this is the challenge to find suitable Catholic organizations that will accept the chalice or ciborium and ensure they are used to honour the Sir Knight so named. The officers have met and after considering 7 options it has been proposed to honour all future deceased Sir Knights by making an annual contribution to a Seminarian Education Fund in the Sir Knights name. Please take time to read the motion published in this newsletter. This motion will be voted on at the June 19th meeting. Please be advised that after careful analysis of the cost of the chalice program and the difficulty in finding suitable homes for the engraved vessels, the officers of Bishop Paul Reding Assembly have arrived at this decision thoughtfully and with due diligence. We believe this is the correct and best method to honour our departed Sir Knights.

Sir Knight Ron Sullivan Faithful Navigator Bishop Reding Assembly 1981

- Whereas it has been the practice of the Assembly to provide an engraved Chalice or Ciborium for each deceased Knight in good standing, and
- Whereas upon careful review by the Assembly's Officers it has been determined that this practise is no longer financially sustainable due to ever-increasing purchasing and engraving costs coupled with declining revenue from annual dues, and
- Whereas the Assembly is desirous of maintaining a program of recognition for its deceased members,

It is moved that:

Bishop Paul Reding Assembly will provide an annual donation of \$500.00 to Catholic Missions in Canada, (CMIC) to be directed towards Seminarian Education. This shall be used exclusively for the education of Seminarians at the mission dioceses funded by CMIC. The Assembly's Officers may approve a donation greater than \$500.00 but not to exceed the funds allocated to the Memorial Fund from the annual dues. Donations will be made prior to the Annual Memorial Mass. A joint certificate will be prepared and signed by CMIC and Bishop Paul Reding Assembly stating a donation has been made on behalf of each deceased Sir Knight. The certificate honouring the deceased Sir Knight will be presented to each family at the Annual Memorial Mass. In so adopting this program we enact the principles of the Knights of Columbus and support our Catholic Faith in Canada.
