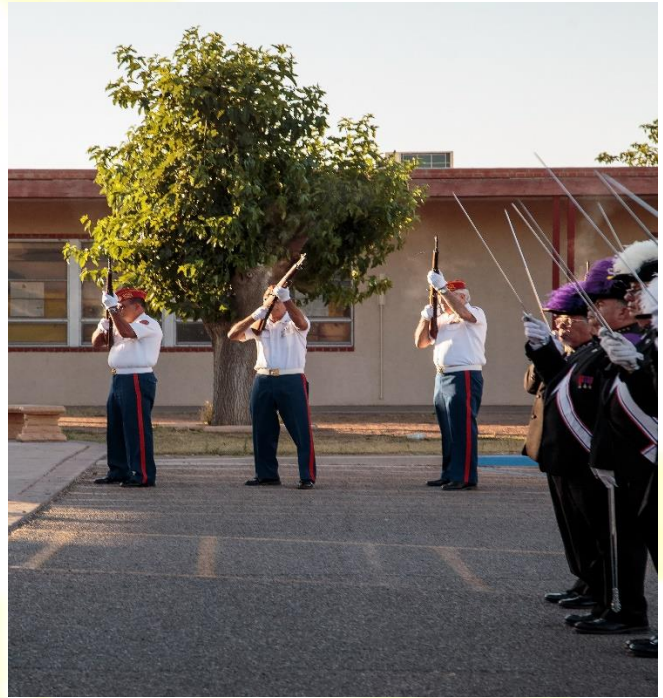
Navigator's Message
