This year, in addition to two busloads of veterans from the Loch Raven VA Center, veterans from the Perry Point VA Center will be attending. These veterans are more mobile, so we need volunteers to help with games such as horseshoes, and walks within the park.

We can provide fresh fruits and vegetables. The picnic has quickly become our Assembly's "signature event" and it takes many of our Assembly's members to plan and execute it.
