Arizona cemeteries, possibly Arizona Memorial Cemetery in Marana or East Lawn Cemetery in Tucson on December 19, 2020.

What is it? Wreaths Across America (WAA) is an organization that coordinates wreath-laying ceremonies at Arlington National Cemetery as well as more than 2,100 additional locations in all 50 U.S. states, at sea and abroad.

There is Veterans Day in the Fall and Memorial Day in the Spring, but our service members sacrifice their time and safety every single day of the year to preserve our freedom.

Our Worthy Faithful Navigator Dan Pinda will be playing Taps at the service in Marana. We will ask our members to support a donation for wreaths on behalf of our assembly. Please consider personal donations for this worthwhile cause.

**Father McGivney Beatified**

October 31 was a day of great joy for the Knights of Columbus as our beloved founder was officially declared Blessed at a Beatification Mass in Hartford, CT. His feast day is August 13, the day in between his birth date of August 12 and death date of August 14.
