I ask that as many Knights as possible write letters to the editors of their local papers: The Arizona Republic, The Arizona Daily Star, The Valley Tribune, Kingman Daily Miner, Flagstaff paper, etc. etc. Whatever paper serves your community needs to know the story. This should be done without attacking the paper. Instead of fighting over the sex abuse stories and whether there has been a settlement or not. let's tell the TRUE story: How good priests have served us; how the St. Vincent De Paul Society feeds and shelters the poor: how the Knights of Columbus support special olympics and mentally challenged children; the charity of Catholic hospitals; how Catholic Social Services has served the immigrant or refugee.

It is particularly important that your letter get to the paper this week. Bishop O'Brien's "Op Ed " editorial in The Arizona Republic today should mark the beginning of Catholics going on the offense. We love our Church and She does tremendous good. Let's tell the story.
