As we begin the season of Autumn, we begin preparations for the busy months ahead. At the present time there are no scheduled events for October other then the General Meeting scheduled for October 16th, 7.30 PM at Marian Hall. The installation of officers was completed on September 18th by our Worthy Dan Lohin and Marshall Jay

Raats. On September 21st we attended the Star Gala Awards to assist in welcoming the participants, and then provided an Honour Guard to escort the dignitaries and participants into the event. On September 27th an honour guard was provided at the wake of Sir Knight Pio Gomes who passed away September 22nd. On the following morning, September 28th the Funeral mass for Sir Knight was held and an honour guard provided. Although our numbers were sparse, which was disappointing, I want to thank all the Sir Knights who came out and participated.

Following the Funeral Mass, I attended the District Masters meeting held at St James Parish. Due to my attendance at the Mass I arrived only for the last 30 minutes of the meeting. Fortunately, SK Renfred D'Souza, Faithful Captain, was in attendance on behalf of Bishop Reding Assembly. From what I was able to review from the agenda it was a very comprehensive meeting.

The dress code and uniform policy were reviewed, and it was stressed that the new uniform is the official dress for all Colour Guard or Honour Guard activity. Below is a clarification from the Supreme Vice Master:

Official Events – An official event is any event where we are requested to serve, such as Funerals, Masses, Church and school events, parades, etc.

The rule of thumb shall be ANY and ALL CALL OUTS wherein the past, protocol you followed with the old regalia, that same protocol would apply for when the uniform is worn. Colour Corps shall be allowed to process.

For Official Knights of Columbus functions – Only the Colour Corps shall be allowed to process.

For parades and other public celebrations – Members may process (following the Colour Corps if available) wearing their tuxedo or dark business suit with the Social Baldric. (No Gloves, Service Baldric or Sword).

For Funerals – Members may process (following the Colour Corps if available) wearing their tuxedo or dark business suit with the Social Baldric (No Gloves, Service Baldric or Sword).

Any and All Honour Guard/Colour Guard (Colour Corps) functions shall only be preformed by members in Uniform.

Uniform refers to the New Uniform consisting of the official Navy-Blue Blazer with crest, dark grey trousers, black shoes and socks, official 4th tie, beret with official badge, white gloves, service baldric with sword and 4th pin.

The Master provided me with further clarification as follows;

At Funeral Visitation members wearing the tuxedo with social baldric or members dressed in a dark suit with social baldric may stand guard positioned at the head and foot of the casket. No gloves, service baldric, sword, cape or chapeau is permitted.

Further clarification regarding who is entitled to funeral honours is found in the Colour Corps Manual issued February 2018, it states, "Without exception, honours by the Honour Guard shall be offered to deceased Sir Knights, their immediate family members, Council members and to their immediate family members provided a request is made. It must be distinctly understood that the wishes of the family of the deceased member are paramount and will be given the fullest consideration as to the selection of elements of the Honour Guard involved, if any. "

However, it is understood that Assemblies need to be able to provide enough members to comply.

The Master gave a report on the Canadian Catholic Military Scholarship Program. Bishop Scott McCaig, CC, head of the Military Ordinariate of Canada, has requested the assistance of the Knights of Columbus in Canada with the sponsorship of a fund-raising campaign on their behalf to offset the shortfall in funding from Government sources. This effort would establish a scholarship fund generated and supported by the K of C to train and enroll future chaplains, to meet the growing Catholic religious and spiritual demands of the men and women in uniform. A motion was passed in August 2017 by the Canadian Association of the Knights of Columbus that agreed to assist with the Bishop's request to support a fund-raising campaign that would be conducted by the Fourth Degree in each jurisdiction. The Knights of Columbus will endeavour to establish a scholarship fund of \$100,000.

In closing I want to wish all Sir Knights and their families a Happy and Blessed Thanksgiving.
