# Exemplification on November 3 in Hagerstown

A Patriotic (Fourth) Degree Exemplification will be held on Saturday, November 3, at Pangborn Assembly in Hagerstown, MD. Unlike the annual Exemplification that is now held in Ocean City, this will be a one-day event. It provides an opportunity for those not able to travel to Ocean City next spring (March 8-9, 2019) to receive the Patriotic (Fourth) Degree. Please publicize this to Knights in your Council who have received their Knighthood (Third) Degree.

A Form 4 to apply for the Patriotic Degree can be obtained by contacting Faithful Comptroller Rick Murray at <a href="mailto:murray20794@comcast.net">murray20794@comcast.net</a>. The last opportunity for Our Assembly to consider and approve candidates is at the October 25 meeting, so time is of the essence.

The Color Corps, including members of our Assembly's Color Corps, will assist in the ceremony, which begins at 11:15 am. There will also be a Ladies activity starting at 11:00 am. Ladies' dress is Sunday Church dress. All Assembly Sir Knights are welcome to participate, in the Fourth Degree uniform. Tickets for the lunch are available for Sir Knights and guests at \$40 each, and may be purchased online, but must be purchased by October 27. The meal includes a fruit and cheese tray. sweet and sour meatballs, a shrimp tray, round of eye roast beef, fettuccine alfredo for those who do not desire meat, mashed potatoes, mixed vegetables, brown gravy mix, mixed salad, cake, mixed fruit, water, soda, beer, and wine. There will be a cash bar.

# Veterans Day Celebration in Howard County on November 11

Veterans Day provides an opportunity for all of us to honor the veterans who have served our country. Although it is not an event specifically sponsored by our Assembly, in commemoration of the 100th anniversary of Armistice Day, Howard County will honor Veterans Day with a parade and ceremony on Sunday morning, November 11, in Columbia.

The parade will begin at 9:30 am at Merriweather Drive and Little Patuxent Parkway, and proceed to the Downtown Columbia Lakefront. The Ceremony will begin at 10:45 am at the Lakefront, and will feature comments by Howard County Executive Allan Kittleman, Columbia Association President/CEO Milton Matthews, and emcee Howard County Veterans Foundation President Robert Gillette. Colors will be presented by the Atholton High School JROTC. There will also be a performance by the Columbia Center for Theatrical Arts.

There will be free hot chocolate and coffee, provided by event sponsor Clyde's of Columbia; bakery items, provided by event sponsor Whole Foods; and flags for kids, provided by the Columbia Association. Additional food items may be purchased from food trucks. A card-making station for troops will be set up, and vintage military vehicles will be on display.

The Fourth Degree is a group of outstanding Knights, dedicated to promoting patriotism enlightened by their Catholic faith. These Knights, perform exemplary deeds for God, country, and for the Order. The Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus unite to support religious, civic and charitable causes.

Fourth Degree members belong to local units called assemblies. Each assembly is involved in a wide range of public patriotic activities.

Each assembly maintains a Fourth Degree Color Corps and Honor Guard. Uniformed members wearing beret, crested coat, tie, baldric, and sword or colorful capes, chapeaux and swords participate in special civic and religious ceremonies. For this reason, the Fourth Degree is often called the visible arm of the Knights of Columbus.
