DIOCESE OF HAMILTON ACQUIRES HERITAGE EDITION OF SAINT JOHN'S BIBLE



The Diocese of Hamilton is happy to announce the acquisition of a copy of the **Heritage Edition of the Saint John's Bible**. Bishop Douglas Crosby, OMI, and Msgr. Murray Kroetsch (above) welcomed the first volume of The Saint John's Bible to its home in our Diocese at Bishop Farrell Library & Archives. The Saint John's Bible is a modern day illuminated bible intended "to ignite the spiritual imagination of believers throughout the world."

To commemorate the arrival of the first volume, Gospel and Acts, there will be an Evening of Prayer and Lecture at the *Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King* on **September 15, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.** The remaining six volumes will be received over the next 20 months.

In 1998, Saint John's Abbey and University commissioned renowned calligrapher Donald Jackson to produce the first handwritten, hand-illuminated Bible since the invention of the printing press. This work of art is one of a kind in our modern era!

Through the Heritage Edition communities around the world can use this gift of sacred art to ignite their spiritual imaginations for generations to come.


