Greetings Sir Knights!

Identifying Oneself as a Knight Online and in Public Forums

Although any member of the Knights of Columbus is free to express his opinion on matters of public concern (such as proposed legislation, judicial decisions, public controversies, judicial nominations, ballot initiatives, and elections), he may not identify himself as a member of the Knights of Columbus on social media, letters to the editor, open letters, or other means of public communication. This rule applies also to communications by or on behalf of councils and assemblies. Any member who wishes to engage in public discourse on matters of political, social, or cultural significance is instructed to do so as an individual citizen and not as a member of the Knights of Columbus, a representative of his council/assembly, or a spokesman for the Order as a whole.

When the Knights of Columbus speaks about matters of public concern, it does so through the Communications Department of the Supreme Council. Because consistency and discipline in messaging are important, the Order must speak in one unified voice. When issues arise, the Communications Department will determine whether and how to express the position of the Knights of Columbus.

If a council or assembly receives from a journalist an inquiry or a request for comment on a matter *other than* ordinary Knights of Columbus charitable and fraternal activities, the journalist should be referred to the Communications Department at Supreme Council headquarters, which can be reached at communicationsdept@kofc.org.
