Almost the entire month of May consists of the Easter Season. The Acts of the Apostles reveals how the early Church responded to reports of an empty tomb and the appearances of the Risen Lord. Without much thought, the Church's response was to *gather*. The first

Christians banded together and through their gatherings the Holy Spirit paved the way for future generations of Christians. The Acts of the Apostles mentions four types of gatherings in response to the Resurrection. Gatherings in the Upper Room. Gatherings in the Temple. Gatherings in homes. Outdoor gatherings in public.

These gatherings represent how we still gather today as Catholic Christians. We maintain our connection to the Apostles in the Upper Room through the bishops and the pope when they gather. We gather in our local "temples" for the Holy Mass. Prayer at home is essential to maintaining a healthy family and a strong faith. We give witness to our faith at all kinds of public gatherings from Eucharistic processions to parish picnics, to recreational and sporting events. If we do not gather, then we are not functioning as the Body of Christ the Church. To be sure, we need all four types of gatherings to stay banded together and let the Holy Spirit lead.

As Knights, we can use these four types of gatherings to examine how we are supporting the work of the Church. In order to give witness to the reality that Jesus is alive today, we must be ambassadors of the Gospel with courage and with love at all four types of gatherings. We support the bishops, we support

the parish, we support the family, and we support public witnessing in the open air. Look at your calendars and see what you have planned in May and June to "gather" as the Church. Look at your checkbook and see how you are supporting the work of the Church as she gathers.

"Where two or three gather in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (Mt 18:20). May you keep the Holy Name present in all of your gatherings in the month of May. God Bless! He is risen! Alleluia!
