#### **ASSEMBLY & SUPREME NOTICES**

NOTES FROM SUPREME—1) A revised Patriotic Degree is in the final stages of development and testing. It is anticipated to go into use on or about February 22, 2025, in conjunction with the 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Fourth Degree. 2) Effective July 1, 2024, social baldrics will no longer be given out at exemplifications. Wearing of the social baldric is grandfathered in for members without the new uniform for wear with their tuxedo at social gatherings. New members may purchase one, if so desired, for wear in settings requiring a tuxedo. 3) Effective July 1, 2024, the official Fourth Degree uniform is the preferred attire for exemplifications. Candidates may also wear dark suits. Tuxedos may not be worn by candidates. 4) In SOCIAL SETTINGS ONLY members may wear their Fourth Degree name badges on the RIGHT breast aligned with top left pocket. Badges must have magnet or pin backing.

**OFFICIAL DRESS UNIFORM**—Bishop Flaherty Assembly has established a Uniform Fund which will subsidize a portion of the cost for buying the new Fourth Degree uniform. This Uniform Fund is administered by the Trustees of our Assembly and funds are distributed based on need and availability of funds.
