



Display booths officially opened at 2:00 PM. The convention's opening Mass was celebrated at 4:30 PM. This was followed by the State Council Opening Dinner at 6:00 PM. For fun and entertainment of the day, the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Corn Hole Tournament took place at 7:00 PM. The evening closed out with the State Caucus at 9:30 PM





# Father Patrick J. Murphy Assembly 2420 Saint John the Baptist Catholic Church 1055 Hughes Road, Madison, Alabama 35758

Within six years of the founding of St. John the Baptist Council 10232 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Madison, Alabama, the 4th degree Assembly of St. John the Baptist No. 2420 was established on April 13, 1996 with 25 charter members. The Assembly was originally named "Saint John the Baptist Assembly, No. 2420" and Sir Knight Wayne L. Sovocool was elected as the charter Faithful Navigator. Father Patrick J. Murphy, the founding pastor of Saint John the Baptist Catholic parish, was named our Chaplain. In 2002, the Assembly was renamed the Father Patrick J. Murphy Assembly, 2420 in honor of Father Murphy who had passed away in 1998.

The Assembly has grown steadily in membership over its almost 26-year history, and since its inception has been very active in the parish and community. Along with the Council, we share a sense of pride in working with our Pastors to serve the parish and our neighbors in time of need. Assembly members are active participants in many activities such as the Madison Street Festival, Madison Christmas Parade, Veterans Day Parade, assisted in a bimonthly blood drive at the parish, purchased, and erected four flag poles in the City of Madison, and working with local veteran organizations to conduct public flag retirement ceremonies. In addition, the Assembly also conducts frequent honor guards for special Masses and funerals.

Assembly 2420 makes its home at 1055 Hughes Road in Madison, Alabama, and warmly invites any 4<sup>th</sup> degree member visiting the area to attend the Assembly meetings. Meetings are held every second Thursday of each month at 7:30 PM in the Knights Meeting Room located in the basement of the church. The current Faithful Navigator is Sir Knight Steven W.
