

The month of July is dedicated to the Blood. The feast of Precious the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. Knights of Columbus Council 8521 not only supporting Vacation Bible School through monetary means, but also through <u>action</u>.







SAN ANTONIO SEMINARIANS SPRING 2024



OUR FOUNDER



Recognizing a need in his community, Father Michael J. McGivney, the 29-year-old assistant pastor of St. Mary's Church in New Haven, Conn., gathered a group of men at his parish on Oct. 2, 1881. He proposed establishing a lay organization to prevent Catholic men from entering secret societies antithetical to Church teaching, uniting Catholic men and helping families of deceased members.

Thanks to the efforts of Father Michael J. McGivney and some of his parishioners, the Connecticut state legislature on March 29, 1882, officially chartered the Knights of Columbus as a fraternal benefit society.

The primary motivation for the Order was to be a mutual benefit society. As a parish priest in an immigrant community, McGivney saw what could happen to a family when the breadwinner died and wanted to provide insurance to care for the widows and orphans left behind.

McGivney had originally conceived of the name "Sons of Columbus" but James T. Mullen, who would become the first Supreme Knight, successfully suggested that "Knights of Columbus" would better capture the ritualistic nature of the new organization.

The Order is still true to its founding principles of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism.

The Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization with over 2 million members in over 16,000 councils throughout the world, with nearly 200 councils on college campuses. Membership is limited to "practical Catholic" men aged 18 or older.
