





Members of St. Joseph's at Honey Creek Council 8521 and Father Virgilius Draessel Assembly 3439 in Spring Branch, Texas, and priests from St. Joseph Catholic Church gather around a new Ten Commandments monument commissioned for the parish by the Knights. The project began as an idea of council member Skip White and another parishioner, but a committee of Knights worked to bring it to fruition after White was diagnosed with Lou Gehrig's disease. An anonymous council member donated \$10,000 and Knights raised an additional \$4,600 to fund the monument, which was erected in December 2023 and blessed by pastor Father Mike English (second from right) in January.




