### The Following Information Is Reprinted From Last Month's Supreme Master Newsletter:

Communications is the key to success. Sometimes information can become distorted when it is delivered multiple times. Below are some clarifications made directly from the Supreme Master on subjects that need to be clearly communicated:

- 1. A Revised Patriotic Degree is in the final stages of development and testing. It is anticipated to go into use on or about February 22, 2025, in conjunction with the 125th Anniversary of the Fourth Degree.
- 2. Effective July 1, 2024, social baldrics will no longer be given out at exemplifications. Wear of the social baldric is grandfathered in for members without the new uniform for wear with their tuxedo at social gatherings. New members may purchase one, if so desired, for wear in settings requiring a tuxedo.
- 3. Effective July 1, 2024, the official Fourth Degree uniform is the preferred attire for exemplifications. Candidates may also wear dark suits. Tuxedos may not be worn by candidates.
- **4**. In **SOCIAL SETTINGS ONLY** members may wear their Fourth Degree name badges on the **RIGHT** beast aligned with top left pocket. Badges must have magnet or pin backing.
