

Each of you have truly epitomized what a true Knight is.

### Remembering SK Paul M. Turner

May 26, 1935 - January 7, 2020

Paul M. Turner, 85, died January 7, 2020, at his residence in Liberty Heights Senior Living in north Colorado Springs.

Paul was born in Wichita, Kansas on May 26, 1935 to Maxine and Paul Turner. In 1957 Mr. Turner married his wife Mary Kathryn ("Kay") Wittmann. The two had met while students at Municipal University of Wichita, today's Wichita State University.

Paul was commissioned a 2nd Lieutenant in the United States Army in 1958. He served proudly on active duty throughout the 1960s and early 1970s with assignments in the 3rd Armor Division, 5th Infantry Division, and Training & Doctrine Command. He also completed two yearlong deployments to Vietnam with Military Assistance Command - Vietnam earning two Bronze Stars for his service. Paul continued to work for the Department of the Army throughout the remainder of his life serving as a civil servant ultimately retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel and GM -15 as the Director of Plans, Training, Mobilization and Security at Fort Bliss, TX.



Paul was an active member of the Catholic community

wherever he lived. In Colorado Springs, he donated his time to several charities. He will be remembered by many Colorado Springs residents for his weekly volunteer work with Meals on Wheels, delivering food to the less fortunate, always with Kay by his side. Paul was also a proud member of the St. Patrick's Knights of Columbus.

Paul was a quiet strength to his wife and sons. He was also a proud grandfather. Shortly before his death he became a great-grandfather as well.

Paul is survived by his beloved Kay, and his two sons, Mark and Gregory. His eldest son, Paul M. Turner III, also a resident of Colorado Springs, died in 2015.




# Remembering SK Charles J. "Chuck" Zeitvogel

4 Sept 1935 - 21 Jan 2021 Chief Master Sergeant, U.S. Air Force, Retired

Charles J. "Chuck" Zeitvogel passed away at home on January 22, 2021 of natural causes. He was born in Rochester, New York on September 4, 1935 and grew up on a farm near Byron with four siblings. While still in high school, he enlisted in the Army National Guard. At the age of 20, he joined the United States Air Force and traveled the world for 30 years retiring as a Chief Master Sergeant. Among his many assignments, he especially enjoyed his time in Ankara, Turkey and Kadena Air Force Base in Okinawa, Japan.

After retirement, Chuck continued to serve his church and community as an active leader in Boy Scouts, the American Legion Post 209, The Knights of Columbus, and The Retired Enlisted Association. A lifelong learner, he received an Associate Degree in Applied Science, Food Technology in 1955 from State University of New York at Morrisville. Chuck then obtained his Bachelor of Art degree in Business Administration from Wittenberg University OH in 1975, and finally his Master of Science in Public



Administration from the University of Colorado Colorado Springs in 1991.

Chuck gave back to the people around him by volunteering to help do taxes for the VITA program and the AARP. He entertained and educated young people as a docent at the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo and engaged all ages through Toastmasters. He was a member St Patrick's Catholic Church for over 30 years and served there as in various capacities.

He was a thoughtful husband, wonderful father, and beloved grandparent. He leaves behind his wife Veronica; son Chris; daughter Marla, her husband Marty and their three children Derek, Callista, and Phoebe; daughter Lisa, her husband Mike and their four children Corrie, Katie, Gregory, and Elizabeth. He also leaves his brother Bill and sister Mary, as well as stepchildren and grandchildren.

Visitation for Chuck was held Wednesday February 10, 2021 at 5:30 PM, and Mass on Thursday February 11, 2021 at 10AM located at St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Church, at 6455 Brook Park Dr. Colorado Springs, Colorado 80918. Chuck was laid to rest following services at Pikes Peak National Cemetery.


