

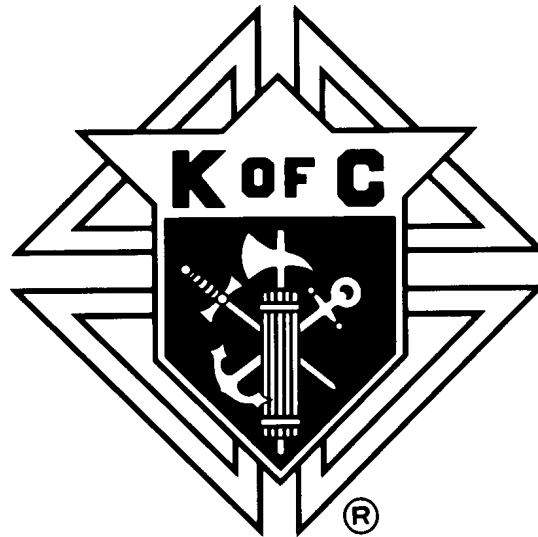

The First New Year's Eve in Times Square Was Meant to Celebrate What Business' Arrival There?

In 1904, Adolph Ochs, the owner of The New York Times, was looking for a way to celebrate the newspaper's new building in Times Square. So he decided to throw a party. That party saw 200,000 people turn out for the all-day celebration which was finished off with a round of fireworks. Three years later, they decided to drop a 700-pound ball made of iron and wood, and covered in light bulbs, as part of the celebration. Today, there's roughly a million people coming out to Times Square on New Year's Eve, and that ball is just shy of 12,000 pounds, with somewhere in the neighborhood of a billion viewers tuning in to watch it all happen on their TVs. In other words, it seems the tradition has taken off.
