Your Knights are pleased to announce that with your support throughout the year, Saint Teresa of Calcutta Council was able to support a \$1,800.00 donation as follows in this summary: Archbishop Rozika and Father Daniel have been working with an organization in New York, called Fertility Education and Medical Management (FEMM) to train diocesan health care providers in Tabora, Tanzania on a comprehensive women's health care program. This Vatican-endorsed program leads to natural family planning, but also includes a wider variety of women's health training, centered around teaching women to better understand their bodies and how to recognize hormonal and other vital signs of health, and help women track their health and reproductive goals. The Archbishop is working with FEMM and possibly the Vatican Section on Migrants and Refugees to train a large cadre of health providers across his diocese.

Out donation funds on-line FEMM training for first two Tabora diocesan health providers in their next program beginning January 10, 2018. At the same time, the diocese is seeking additional Vatican funding for on-line training for 12 more diocesan health providers.

Thank you, our home parish, for all your support in 2017. This is one of several things we have been able to accomplish. Thank you and Happy New Year 2018.
