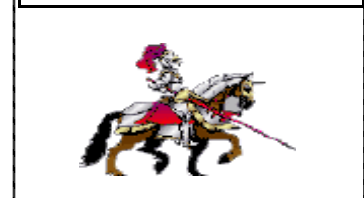

Grand Knight's Report

Brother Tom DiBenedetto has volunteered to head up that effort. The dinner will be Saturday, June 2nd. At the next business meeting, the Council will begin to formalize the event and look for volunteers to help.

Immediately following the Homily, participants will remove their socks and shoes, walk down to the altar and have their feet washed by either Father Marc or Deacon Bill.
