# The Mystery that Calls to Win over the World

Dear Brother Knights,

As we continue our journey through the holy season of Lent and awaiting the Holy Week culminating in Holy Easter, I gladly invite each of you to spend ample time in reflecting about the journey of your faith. A Christian who is deeply rooted in faith will find meaning and enrichment in the mystery of the Holy Week (Maundy Thursday – the institution of the Holy Eucharist, washing of feet (love based on servant attitude), Good Friday (the power and virtue of Jesus's sufferings), and the mystery of the resurrection of Jesus Christ). The joy of the Resurrection of Jesus takes us to a new and different dimension of our discipleship in this earthly life.

Placing trust in the resurrected Christ was really a challenging turn over in the lives of the disciples of Jesus. Speaking in human terms there were lots of uncertainties in their lives after the horrific and heart breaking events of the night of Passover and the Good Friday. Their future seemed to be in darkness, for they had left everything when they followed Jesus. But now Jesus their Master is killed!!! But they took the courageous step of the journey of faith. It reminds me of a quote which says, **"Faith is taking the first step even when you don't see the whole stair case."** 

Believing in the infinite value and power of the holy Passion, death and resurrection of Jesus, and molding our Christian discipleship in the mystery of our faith that we profess in every Holy Mass is a challenge. This fills our hearts with real joy, peace and a hope beyond what we see with our naked eyes. This Paschal Mystery calls us for a radical change in our Christian life just like the apostles and the early Christian community who witnessed to this truth. Always be aware that we believe in a God who conquered sin and death. This God is always with us who said, **"In the world you will have troubles, but take courage, I have conquered the world."** (John 16:33)
