

A NOTE FROM TOM EILFER:

I want to start out by apologizing to all who will receive this email and already know all about the stroke I just experienced last week. For most of you, there will be precious little info here that's new. I just thought that one update would be best for all, as there are several people who don't know anything about it yet..

Last Thursday, at about 12:15 p.m., I had a sudden inability to move my right arm, my right leg, and the right hand side of my mouth. MaryAnn called 911 immediately and, within five minutes, there were two ambulances here plus one police car. The EMT's loaded me into one of the ambulances and drove me to Parkland Medical Center in Derry, NH. Once there, I was examined by a cardiologist, who recommended that I receive an injection of something called TCP. (It could have been TPA; I forget.) This is a drug which, if administered within 3.5 hours of the onset of the stroke, has a great deal of success counteracting the stroke's negative and potentially long-lasting effect

The drug worked so well that the doctors, nurses, and other hospital staff referred to my recovery as a "miracle" and about four of them mention to me in the days that followed that I was lucky to be alive. There followed a whole battery of tests (a CAT scan; an EKG; an MRI for which I was transported by ambulance at about 11 p.m. to Catholic Medical Center because Parkland's MRI equipment was too small to accommodate me; and a TEE, which was the last test I took).

Bottom line: I was released to my own home this last Tuesday with instructions to see my GP and my cardiologist with whom I already have appointments. I have 100% of my motor skills in my right arm and my right side; I have no slurring of my speech; and I have virtually no ill-effects from the stroke, except for a general weakness/sleepiness, which already is much better than when I came home on Tuesday.

So, that's about it. Thank you for all your prayers and good wishes. I'm already up and around, and I expect to see many of you around in the next few weeks, especially once I get cleared to drive again, which I hope will be in a week or two.


