Grand Knight's Report

The Grand Knight thanked Brother Joe Passanise for his work on the sign, which is now in place in front of the church.

The GK and Deputy GK attended the business meetings at the State Convention on April 28 – 30. The meeting included State Officer reports and State Officer elections. The GK and DGK participated on the Budget and Per Capita Committee, and to keep the per capita the same, minor adjustments to the budget were made by the committee. The Campaign for People with Intellectual Disabilities is not a line item. 70% of the Tootsie Roll money comes back to the Council and the other 30% is donated at the state level. No money is kept by the state. Our Council came in second place for medium sized councils for the amount of money collected. Awards were also given out and our Council received second place in the community activity category for our monthly dinners. We also came in third place in the family activities category for our Breakfast with Santa. In addition, there were scholarships given out, Campaign for People with Intellectual Disabilities money was distributed, and individual awards were distributed for office holders. A crystal trophy was presented to Dylan Denton for the Free Throw Contest. The Grand Knight attended the banquet with Dylan and his parents. Overall this was a good experience for our GK and DGK with good sharing of information and best practices with other councils.

The Grand Knight presented the Knight of the Month Award to Brother Chuck Mack for all of his hard work as Membership Director. Chuck has brought new candidates to the Council and has greatly contributed to our growth. We are now one of the top recruiting councils in the state with a current total of 6 new members (+1 more onboarding).

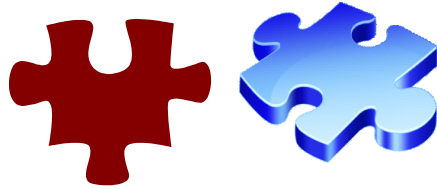
