## Dear Brother Knights in Christ,

Christian vocation is a great call to love. What is that love? "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:13) This love is not merely the love and care we show to our own family – spouse, children, siblings, in –laws, grandchildren etc. Of course that is very much needed – but that arises from a commitment – it's our responsibility. This sort of love and commitment is not something peculiar to Christians alone, rather it is universal love expressed by humans (even animals, birds etc.) to those who are near and dear to them. But the love of a Christian should exceed all these, as Jesus says, "I tell you, unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter into the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 5:20)

I could help some poorest of the poor with that, and they are really grateful to that kind act of yours. This is a clear sign that our service should go across the world – beyond this nation. As we celebrate the Assumption of Blessed Mother (August 15<sup>th</sup>) – let us learn to engage ourselves to look at the things of heaven and continue this pilgrimage in the spirit of Christian love.
