I want to wish everybody a safe Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

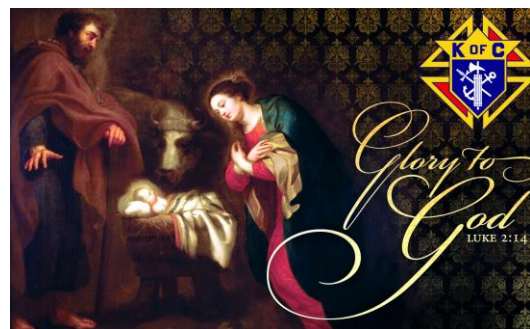
