2014 Annual Fr. Ryan Memorial Thanksgiving Day Food Drive

Thank you to the Knights, St. Andrew The Apostle students earning Service Hours, and the generous parishioners who supported our annual Fr. Ryan Memorial Thanksgiving Day Food Drive. This event began on Saturday, November 22nd in parking lot of St Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church (6720 Union Mill Rd, Clifton, VA), and continued until 1:30 PM on Sunday, November 23rd, collecting donations before and after all masses. This year, with the help of Brother Knights, their families and friends, and the generosity of our fellow parishioners, we collected a total of 241 boxed meals, 229 turkeys, 19 boxes of miscellaneous food items, and several cases of canned vegetables. Of these amounts, volunteers from St. Clare of Assisi Council #12963 collected 48 boxed meals and 46 turkeys. We donated 18 boxed meals, 17 turkeys, and 3 boxes of miscellaneous food items to St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church. The remainder of the collection was donated to the Western Fairfax Christian Ministries. This is a very labor-intensive event and we appreciate our as fellow Knights, and their wives and children who help us with this wonderful event to assist needy families in our parish and community.
