I offer them for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart: the salvation of souls, reparation for sins, the reunion of all Christians;


I offer them for the intentions of our Bishops and of all Apostles of Prayer and in particular for those recommended by our Holy Father this month. Amen.


Located just north of the Club House, the first few statues have been installed — one of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and two Guardian Angels. Additional
