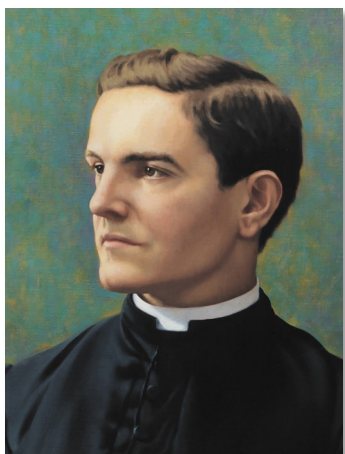

- Financial Secretary Report — no report
