Insurance check-up for 2016

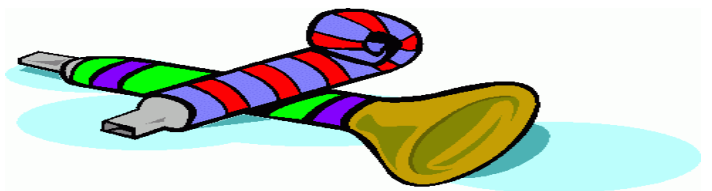
