June 2016 Activities

May 28th, Saturday – Corpus Christi Procession at St. Cecilia in Beaverton – attracted about 500 people including 5 from Council # 3179 (Dwayne Fellis, Doug Klein, Bob Lienhard, Larry Culbertson and Jerry McAfee). The procession was around St. Cecilia's church which made 2 stops, one at the Veteran's Park and the other at the library. There was a Knights Color Corp guard and Brother Knights held moving ropes to control the procession through the streets. The Brother Knights from Council # 6266 Fr. Luke O'Donnell (who have tremendously help at the Grotto Shrine Project) extended the invitation and were very thankful for our participation.

June 2nd, Thursday at 7:30 pm General Membership Meeting

18 Brother Knights were present during the meeting and the following items were discussed:

- Fr. Zach reminded all that the next day June 3rd will be the Feast of Sacred Heart of Jesus which will celebrate the 5 wounds of Our Lord – Fr. Zach read the act of love to the Sacred Heart to all. It is a High Feast celebration.
- Recorder read the minutes of last meeting which included the Council receiving some awards like the Family and Community Activity awards.
- Under communications, a thank you message was received from the Leadon family for all the efforts by the Council specially Bros. Tom Barrie and Larry Rose in facilitating the fundraising dinner which gathered about \$10,500.00 to help Craig Leadon in his fight for cancer after his medical benefits ran out.
- An invitation was received for a reception to welcome His Excellency Joseph Miola of Tanzania on May 22nd at The Becker's home in Portland. Bishop Miola's seminarian education was supported by the Worldwide Seminarian Support project which the Knights of Columbus help funding the project.
- A Plaque for Spiritual Contribution to the Knights of Columbus was presented to Fr. Zach by Bro. John Freuler, Grand Knight Doug Klein and the Council for all his work.
- Bro. John Snyder reported about the Amazon.com project saying that we are now getting quarterly report from that and started to show some movement. This will also be included in the parish bulletin.
- Bro. Marlowe J reported the progress of the making of the Picture-Album of the Grotto Shrine of Guadalupe project.
- Bro. Jerry McAfee on Spiritual adoption at St. Henry's, there will be a birthday and baby-shower in October with birthday cakes and all. The Multnomah county chapter of Oregon Right-to-Life has a booth at the Multnomah county fair on Memorial weekend at Oaks park. Pamphlets and video were at hand for people to peruse. Bro. Larry Rose reported that Knights helped distribute the baby bottles for the Mother-Child project and they are slowly being returned by the parishioners. Thank you all for helping.
- Bro. John Freuler reminded all about the Ladies Nite Out on June 11th, Saturday. Help will be needed around 4pm at the Fireside room. This is our Council family-fun activity.
- Bro. Doug Klein reminded all that Sunday Breakfast for June 5th is on, funds of which will go to Youth Ministry Spokane project.

May 7, larger work part helped with the installation of the concrete walk way (Thanks you My Brothers for all the help, it went off very smoothly)

May 9, removed all forms around the concrete work and clean up the area around the shrine

May 10, Sealed the concrete walkway in and around Our lady Guadalupe shrine

May 12, Added sand to the 2nd coat of sealer to make sure it would not be slippery

June 4, Installed the 3 lights above each of the future Mosaic's

June 4, Installed the shrine walkway path sign (Our Lady of Guadalupe patroness of Americas)

June 4, cleaned up the flower bed in front of the shrine. Moved the edge boulders around the walk way.

Knight of the Month of July 2016 - Jerry McAfee



Gerald McAfee was born and spent most of his life in eastern Pennsylvania. After graduating from Wilkes College and serving three years in the U. S. Army, two of them in Germany, he tried seminary. While working in a school for troubled youth he earned a Masters Degree in Social Work. For the past 28 years he has been working as a dialysis clinic social worker. Six years ago, while working in Allentown, PA., he realized that the dialysis company that he worked for had clinics in northwest Oregon where his brother has been living for over thirty years, so he arranged for a transfer.

For many years Jerry has been active in the pro-life movement and would encourage his fellow Knights to participate in some way in the **40 Days for Life Campaign** which is held twice yearly, spring and fall. In Portland one can participate by praying at a local abortion facility that is chosen as the prayer site or by just praying or fasting for the end of abortion. Jerry leads a pro-life study group at St. Henry and invites Brother Knights to join this small group on the Third Tuesday of each month. He joined the Knights of Columbus thirty-six years ago at the invitation of his landlord at the time. He believes that in the Knights of Columbus, given the high ideals of the order, the men encourage one another to live out the faith. "I love what the Knights stands for and I particularly enjoy the way the men of our Council so selflessly join together to support the parish and worthy causes. I feel honored to be part of this organization," he observes.

Council 3179 is as well honored to have a Brother Knight who epitomizes the spirit of Columbianism in its efforts to evangelize the "Right to Life" of the Catholic Church.




