GRAND KNIGHTS REPORT

The month of January 2016 starts in approximately three weeks. As I set down to write this report I have mixed feelings on the past year. I think we have had a very good year and I think that we could have done better also. I don't think that we could have worked any harder on making our year any better. I think that maybe the process could have been a little better in the communication and the organization of the projects. That being said on December 9, 2015 I conducted an officer and program director meeting at the Parish Center and various subjects were discussed looking to build on the good things we already have and make better the things we need to work on.

Subjects discussed were communications, publicity, year wide campaign, "Year of Mercy", getting members involved in activities, measuring members participation in events. We reviewed all of the pre planned events for next year, including the Priest Appreciation Dinner, Chicken Dinner, Memorial Masses, Lenten Dinners.

At the end of approximately 2 ½ hours of discussion we have decided on several new avenues to pursue to better serve our members. They are listed below:

- We will have a sign in sheet for all activities to start tracking member participation along with the number of hours spent. Program directors of the special event or events will be responsible for getting these sheets signed and turned in.
- 2. Each member will be responsible for keeping his own sheet on a monthly basis for their own activities that only affect his own self. A good example is serving 7:00 AM Masses for a whole week every 5 weeks or serving on the

- 1. Honor Guard for a Funeral or Rosary. Visiting the Sick or incarcerated.

 Delivering communion to the shut in's. Helping the church in an activity that is not a Knights function such as Breakfast Club, Habitat for Humanity, House of Bread, Faith in Action or any of the other ministries that St Francis has.
- 2. Len Archer has accepted the position of Communication and Public Relations Director. His first job is to put together a 2016 Calendar of all of the Events that has been planned thus far and figure a way for all of us to have access of this calendar for our use on a daily basis to better plan our participation. Make sure that we have current e-mail information. Additionally, Len will be doing the publicity of our events to other parishes and the public in St Joseph to advertise our events. Len will also be sending notices to the members of event information etc. Please help Len on his new position.
 - 3. The first question is why we need to know about all of these hours of volunteering. First, we have to turn in to the Supreme and to the State of Missouri Knights of Columbus the hours and money that we spend supporting various charities and events on a yearly basis. Second, we need to know the hours we are spending on all of these activities to report to St Francis and to the community. We need to be able to identify the members who don't participate in the volunteering at the events or meetings. We need to be able to identify members who are going beyond the call of duty in the volunteering for projects and meeting to recognize these people for future awards so the member can be recognized for his participation.
