Jack was born and raised in Kansas City and graduated from Paseo High School. After high school Jack joined the Navy and proudly served his Country in WWII as a Radarman Third Class, USNR-R. Jack had several employers over the years but the one that was near and dear to his heart was the ten years he spent at St. Mary's Hospital in building maintenance.
