The council has been very busy over the past two months, and I appreciate all those Knights who continue our charitable works to the parish and community. August activity highlights included the Officers' Installation and Dinner on the 5<sup>th</sup>, Bingo on the 21<sup>st</sup>, and a Program Meeting on the 25th. ## **Celebrating our Name Sake – Christopher Columbus**

### Columbus Day – Oct 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016

Columbus was regarded as one of the most heroic and significant figures of his or any age. The "Admiral of the Ocean Seas" was celebrated throughout the Americas as a visionary who braved the unknown on a mission of discovery that created a new world.

Columbus has been honored in the United States for nearly as long as the country has existed. The word "Columbia" (land of Columbus) was coined in 1738, perhaps by Samuel Johnson, and was soon adopted in the colonies. Starting during the Revolution, Columbia was revered as the goddess of freedom, as Lady Liberty. The song "Hail Columbia," the music for which was composed for George Washington's inauguration in 1789, was the unofficial national anthem for over a century, and the seat of government for the new country was named the District of Columbia. Columbia became synonymous with America.
