On Tuesday ,November 15th, 4 members of the Knights of Columbus Council 4962 and members of HALO Foundation Kansas City presented a trades fair for 12 homeless teens. Grand Knight, Mike Sweetland, Steve, Stephanie and Joe Hollo from Steve's Auto Service and Francis Okafor provided teens with information about Auto Mechanics, Nursing and Aubony Chafant represented the HALO Foundation. The HALO Foundation is an international organization that provides services and access to resources for homeless children. They have been in existence for many years and can be found in Kansas City, Jefferson City, Portland, New York City and Los Angeles. HALO also provides support in 11 different countries, which include Mexico, Guatemala, Nicaragua, India, Uganda and Kenya. They have 21 distinct programs providing resources to 1200 children. According to Mike Sweetland, the goal of today's event was to introduce homeless teens to potential job opportunities and careers that are available to them after graduating high school or gaining their General Education Diploma (GED). These might be jobs that require an apprenticeship or short time in a collegiate setting at places such as College's Metropolitan Community Technology Center or Health Services Institute. Upon conclusion of the event, which lasted from 6:00 p.m to 7:15 p.m., several of the children's sponsors indicated that more programming such as that needed to happen and that it seemed that the teens were engaged thoughout the event. In the future, along with Trades fair, the Knights of Columbus hope to provide training in light electrical/home repairs, a Robotics and web page development workshops as well as distribute coats, through coats for kids, and care packages generated by the Hollo family. If you'd like to participate or would like more information, contact Sweetland Michael.sweetland@yahoo.com. The next trade fair is tentative scheduled for mid-February 2017.

Donald "Don" John McCuiston died peacefully surrounded by family on December 10, 2014 in Kansas City. He was 76 years old. Don was born on May 23, 1938 at Fort Belknap in Harlem, Montana. He was a tribal member of the Little Shell Chippewa Tribe and an Honorary Warrior in the tribe of Mic - o - Say. In 1948, at the age of 10, he was adopted by Bothen "Mac" and Marian McCuiston of Kansas City. Don was married to Maryann Jenicke on April 4, 1964. They lived in Raytown and attended Our Lady of Lourdes Parish. He retired from Western Electric / A T & T after 32 years of service. Don was an active outdoorsman.
