Message From Our Home Assoc. President

As the saying goes, I have some Good News and I have some Bad News!!

The good news is that with the help of Steve Schmidt, the Real Estate Tax problem looks like it has been resolved! Praise the Lord! Steve met with the Township Tax Assessor and advised them of our current situation and that, in fact, we did NOT have a dedicated Caterer under contract. This, therefore, did NOT violate our Tax Exempt status and hence, NO tax bill will be forthcoming. The Township was quick to add that if we did secure a contracted Caterer in the future, our Tax exempt status could be revoked! Great Job Steve and many thanks!!

The bad news is that the current insurance carrier has advised that they do NOT wish to renew our insurance policy. Stating OUR lack of responding to their underwriting request was the reason not to renew. Jim Berg's & my response to that was, what underwriting request!! Jim is currently following up with the carrier to try to resolve. The bottom line here is, this carrier will NOT provide any kind of liquor liability protection. Accordingly, I have already requested a price quote from another carrier and am waiting for additional information. Unfortunately, the current policy expires February 9th. This will be a very fluent situation and I will keep you posted on all the developments.
