Obviously that is incorrect with the Maple Room alone being about 4,800 square feet. Apparently, the Inspector who came out back in February picked up on the mistake and policy had to be adjusted. We were required to issue a check in the amount of \$426.00 and we financed the balance of the premium adjustment. Crisis averted!!
