The October John Tatham Assembly Meeting will take place on Wednesday, October 11th. We are back to our normal meeting schedule, 6:30 PM Cocktail Hour, 7:30 Dinner, 8:30 Meeting. Meal cost is \$20.00, dress is Jacket and Tie.

I attended the 2nd New Jersey District Master's meeting on Saturday September 9th. At the meeting we were informed that effective July 1, 2018 the Fourth Degree Regalia and the Tuxedo would be retired and would no longer be worn. The Regalia will be replaced by a Blazer, Gray Pants and a Black Baret. The Tux will be replaced by a Black, Blue or Dark Charcoal Gray Suit.

At the 2017 Exemplification a candidate may wear a Tux or opt to wear a Dark Suit. That means if you have thought about taking your Fourth Degree but did not want to buy a Tux, now you don't have to. The Exemplification is in Cherry Hill again this year. There is no telling how long it will stay in Cherry Hill so any Third Degree Knight that want to take his Fourth Degree should see me for an application. Cut off this year for applications is Tuesday November 13th .
