
with shooting being completed by 5:00 pm.

As I gazed at the scene, there was an obvious empty space between the statues of Joseph and Mary waiting for the placement of the baby Jesus. As I reflected on the scene, I realized that there is also an empty space in my heart, in my life, that can only be filled with Jesus. I invited Jesus to fill me in a new way this Christmas; and during the entire new year of 2017 with his presence. Now I desire to take that presence with me into all of my relationships.
