Council #9282 News & Notes

- Bill Walsh and Roch Wegenka represented Council #9282 at the 114th Convention of the Tennessee State Council on April 28-30. They brought home several noteworthy awards:
 - o The State Deputy award awarded to fewer than 12 of TN's 94 Councils
 - The Bishops Award awarded to only 7 of TN's 94 Councils
 - The Markowitz Award awarded to only 4 Councils to recognize their support of their parishes through activities. Last year, our Council had 20 events. In addition, Council #9282 also received the Markowitz Letter, an addendum selected by Mr. Markowitz.
 - Our ID/MR program was also recognized as the 4th-best Top Producer, for the 3rd-best Dollar Increase.
 - SK Mike Porter was elected TN's Insurance Delegate to the KofC National Council. SK Bill Gunter was also elected to a position.
- The 40 Cans for Lent effort was an enormous success. A total of **9,381 lbs.** of canned food were collected and donated throughout Lent to the Mt. Juliet Help Center. Our Council will receive a \$500 check from Supreme Council in recognition of this success...which we will promptly turn over to Father Kibby to use for the benefit of St. Stephen however he sees fit! Our efforts were recognized on the KofC.org website's Knights In Action section.



- At the May 1 meeting, we presented ID/MR Foundation donations from our recent fundraisers to our three recipient organizations:
 - o The <u>Challenger Division</u> of the Mt. Juliet League
 - o Empower Me Day Camp
 - Downs Syndrome Association of Middle TN

- With the departure of Jacob Lamoureux from seminary, our Council has adopted two new Nashville Diocese seminarians. *Nunso Ohanaka* is studying in Columbus, OH, while *Anthony Stewart* is studying in Rome. PLEASE PRAY for these young men!
- Membership Director *SK Alberto Go* points out that Council #9282 members are involved in 28 of the 34 St. Stephen parish ministries which exhibited at our parish's recent Ministry Fair!

It describes what these two went through for many years and how Barbara Rosser and Glenn Merz got to be good friends while in a support group for those who had, or where waiting for, a lung transplant. And eventually, after their spouses' deaths, Barbara and Glenn got to be better friends and eventually married each other. The book then describes what their lives have been like since.
