The Wing Ding planning subcommittee consisting of Ray Heitman, John Catron, Mike Violett, Len Archer and Mike Flowers met on Jun 13th and will be making several new recommendations for improving this year's parish ministry benevolent friendly cooking competition – better known as the SFX Ministry Wing Ding Challenge.

This year's event is planned for Saturday, September 9th. A newly redesigned event schedule will allow for the tasting of Ministry Competition Wings prior to the beginning of serving by the Knights of the main evening meal. The planning committee will recommend that the sponsoring Knights serve a fried chicken dinner (of wings, legs and thighs) making meal preparation and serving more manageable, efficient and cost effective and so as not to place us as the event hosts into a tasting comparison for the Ministry prepared competition BBQ wings. The awarding of competition traveling trophies will be recommended beginning this year to cut overall event costs for future years. Ministries will be allowed and encouraged to provide informational displays or handouts within their table displays as a form of personnel recruitment efforts for their individual groups. This will also allow our Knights Council to likewise perform active membership recruitment efforts within the parish at this event. Advance ticket sales this year will be recommended to also be

extended for availability to the other area Catholic parishes. Competition meat judging rules will only undergo some minor refinements. Some very creative entertainment ideas are also being considered.
