I remember my first pastor, who was also a mentor, speaking about his days in the seminary. When you think of the principles of our Order, charity, unity and fraternity, they could easily be translated as Catholic gentlemen.

The battle for life is brutal and discouraging and can tempt us to resort to tactics and behaviors that are not befitting to us as Catholics and Knights of Columbus. I challenge us to recapture those old-fashioned virtues of civility and politeness and teach this world a valuable lesson. Let us strive as Knights of Columbus to be Catholic gentlemen!
