CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

For the first time that I can recall, this year Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine's Day. Since Ash Wednesday is one of only two solemn days of fast and abstinence (the other being Good Friday), the Bishop has stated very clearly that there can be no dispensation. That means no big steak dinner or a lot of snacking!

While at first glance these two observances would appear to be opposites, on a deeper level they share something in common. Valentine's Day is about love, but so is Ash Wednesday. It is the beginning of Lent, the season to prepare to remember the greatest act of love ever given, the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. Our sacrifices and acts of penance are expressions of love. They express our gratitude to God for what He has done and purify us to live in greater charity to others. So, this year you can't do some of the things you might normally do on Valentine's Day, but the ashes we receive are a reminder and a pledge to become better followers of Jesus—and His way of love, a love that brought Him to the cross.

Annuities: More Flexible Than You Might Think

Annuities are easily misunderstood, in part because of their name. When you “annuitize” the money in your annuity (the money you’ve paid in, plus the interest it has earned), you’ve chosen to receive monthly payments for life, or for a fixed period.

However, annuitizing this money isn’t your only option. You may also treat an annuity like a Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC). That is, you can use the annuity as a way to accumulate savings and earn a steady interest rate. You can make withdrawals from the annuity for any reason, although you may then owe income tax on some, or all, of the withdrawal amount. And, if you do choose to annuitize, you also have several payout options.

The point is, these products are flexible enough to serve a variety of needs.

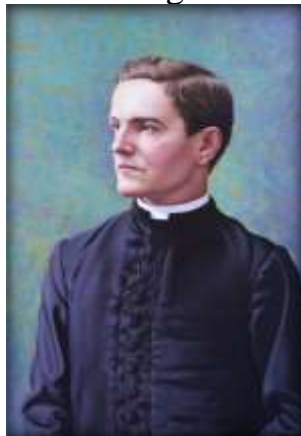
