Ricardo discussed in detail the need to work on fundraising to pay back the \$1,500 given to the group to attend a retreat in LA. Also, it's getting close to the end of the budget year and nothing has been done to use the monies budged for evangelization. They are looking at doing a small retreat.

After Duane talked about the donation of a trailer by Ken Bepple to be used for KC functions, they seemed to be very interested in helping with the restoration. Duane will inform them when the restoration will take place.

They will start a prayer chain to pray for our youth every evening, starting at 8:00 PM, for 5 minutes, hoping that it will stem the attempts by our youth to attempt or commit suicide. Everyone needs to pay close attention to the signs that are troubling our youth and not ignore them.

Unfinished Business:

The Donna Cori Gibson Concert is scheduled for April 8th, starting at 3:30 PM. Duane called them to make sure everything is on schedule for the event and we should be receiving the advertising posters by February 9th. Duane will be contacting the local churches to place a "Save the date" notice in their bulletins. KVBM has already been notified

Ron Suchanek reported that no progress has been made on the bulletin board in the auditorium; waiting for a decision on what to do with the paneling on the walls.

Ron Suchanek discussed the results of the Fraternal Hours for 2017. With the ease of reporting on our WEB site, we double the hours reported as compared to 2017, with over 20,000 hors reported. We had 44 members report their hours online, making Ron's job much easier. Some feel that we still underreporting our hours and we still have many that did not report their hours. The report was sent to Supreme on time. Thanks Ron and Stuart for compiling the results and entering the financials required by Supreme.
